Candidates for High School (8th Grade Students)

Submit applications before February 25, 2018. The STS closed High School placement test will be given at the Training Academy on Randal's Island, Sunday March 4th, Room 260-262. Doors open at 9am; Exam will begin at 10am, Exam is approximately 4 hours.

Eligibility

Candidates for these awards may compete if a parent (natural, step or foster) is a member in good standing of the Columbia Association: Children of deceased members, who were in good standing at the time of their death may also compete. All Decisions are by the Board of Directors and are final. Grand Children are not eligible
